Draft Record Note of the Meeting chaired by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, University of Jammu, Jammu on 04-08-2003 at 11:30 AM in his office chamber.

In the meeting, the following issues were taken up for discussion

 Consequent upon the rationalization process undertaken by the Administrative Department (JKHED) to address very low enrollment/non viability in running some major subjects there is a need to swap major/minor subjects.

It was resolved that students shall be allowed to swap major/minor subject in the 3rd Semester by the JKHED and there shall be no restriction on the number of students swapping major/minor.

2. In order to further address the above mentioned issue, the JKHED shall migrate the students freely among the Colleges affiliated to University of Jammu and the appropriate RR's of the students will be updated by the respective colleges in the appropriate period which shall be reduced from 30 days to 21 days from the last date of Admission – for uploading/ submission of RR for III semester. The Administrative Department (JKHED) shall take up the issue with the administration of ClUJ to ensure hassle free migration between colleges affiliated to Jammu University and Constituent Colleges of Cluster University of Jammu, Jammu. It was resolved that the University

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of Jammu will not be charging the migration fee from the students as a one-time exception for which consolidated list shall be communicated by the Director Colleges, HED, J&K to UoJ.

- Pre-condition of all subjects having been passed in the Semester-I exam, to be eligible for migration shall also be waived off as one time exception.
- 4. For the purpose of determining the number of credits to be eligible for admission to Semester-III, the one credit in practical/tutorial, if passed by the student, should be added in the total earned credits, in case a student is failing in theory. However, the student has to successfully pass the theory paper also subsequently. This will be one time exception for this year only.
- 5. Admission to Sem.-III shall be resumed w.e.f. 07-08-2023 to 14-08-2023 without late fee and with relevant late fee thereafter. For which Nodal Principal shall inform colleges by way of notification in continuity to the earlier notification/ email/letter.
- 6. It has been reported by Principal of various Colleges that there is an issue of non-availability of Multidisciplinary subjects, particularly in those Colleges which are offering only Arts/Humanities.

It was resolved that Environmental Science shall be allowed as a multidisciplinary subject by the JKHED for various colleges immediately. The Convener, Board of Studies in Environmental Sciences shall design the syllabus for the same. However, the terms & conditions laid down by UGC, with reference to multidisciplinary subjects shall be taken into consideration while designing the syllabus.

- 7. The issues pertaining to on-going admissions to Sem.-I of FYUGP through Common Admission Portal were also discussed threadbare. It was resolved that steps shall be taken by JKHED to ensure that the meritorious students, who missed out on general or any other paper in CUET are not put to any disadvantage and get the opportunity to seek admission through non-CUET category. As regards, the quota for non-CUET candidates, Government may take a decision on the same.
- 8. It was impressed upon one and all that in all matters under the jurisdiction of the University, the University shall be taken into confidence beforehand in future.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.

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
